At both the Southern California and the Northern California **PETS** conferences held in March, *ALL President Elects were informed of the NEED to get EVERY club and EVERY Rotarian in the state AWARE that the RLP project is AVAILABLE NOW.*

*RLP applications were turned in, and lists of club names were taken to schedule an RLP Team member to come to the club to give the RLP presentation.*

These **Rotary License Plates** will give Rotary and the clubs the **EXPOSURE** they need to **STAY ALIVE**, and to bring more new members into our clubs.

The **CLUBS DECIDE** each year how the RLP dollars returned to them are spent. The clubs can designate these funds to help find **POLIO**, or they can support the Rotary International **FOUNDATION**, or they can choose to help support a local project. The members submit the RLP applications. The members decide how these dollars should be spent.

### How Many Dollars Come Back to the Clubs???

When someone buys a **SEQUENTIAL** Rotary License Plate for \$75, **\$50 is returned to the CLUB**. Every year thereafter, when one **RENEWS** their RLP for \$40, **\$26 is returned to the CLUB**.

## Can These Questions Be Answered??

Can I put the RLP (Rotary License Plates) on my **LEASED** vehicles? And what happens when my lease is up? **YES**, you can put Rotary License Plates on your leased vehicles. When your lease is up, you can move your RLP to your new vehicle. Submit those applications **NOW!**

Can I purchase my Rotary License Plates with my **CREDIT CARD??** Yes, you can. If you do, your credit card will not be processed until we are ready to turn in our entire 7500 RLP applications. **SUBMIT** your RLP applications **NOW**, and pay later! Sounds good to me!

What is happening to the **CHECKS** that we have submitted for our Rotary License Plates? The RLP Account has been opened and we must deposit every check that we receive, so that no check becomes stale-dated.
